**Information for Poster Presentations**

Dear Presenter,

Thank you for your interest in presenting a poster display at the GSN 2010 Symposium; Great Basin Evolution and Metallogeny. We are pleased that you have chosen to present information in this manner. Our aim is to provide a means of presenting timely information and allowing ample time for discussion among presenters and viewers.

Poster presentations will be held in the Pavilion Rooms on the second floor of John Ascuaga's Nugget Hotel and Casino, located on Interstate 80 East in Sparks, Nevada. The presentations will remain on display throughout the symposium so that all attendees will have an opportunity to view them. Your booth location and number will be provided at the meeting. We ask that presenters set up their booth areas between 8AM and 3PM on Sunday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2010. Posters and core will be displayed during exhibition hours: 5:00 to 8:00 PM on Sunday, 10:00 to 6:30 PM on Monday, May 17<sup>th</sup>; 10:00 AM to 6:30 PM on Tuesday, May 18<sup>th</sup>, and 10:00 AM to 3:30 PM on Wednesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>. Hosted receptions will be held Sunday, Monday, and Tuesday evenings in the poster and exhibition areas. Poster session authors are requested to be present in their booths for at least two hours of the four-day session schedule that do not conflict with the oral presentations or the luncheon speakers. Cards will be posted at each booth for authors to record the times during which, they will be present to discuss their posters. At all other times during exhibition hours, booths will be open for viewing, but presenters need not be in the booth area. Presenters are responsible for materials left in booths at all times. However, security will be provided in the Pavilion Rooms during after-hours. Posters and core should be cleared from the booth area by 8:00 PM on Wednesday, May 19<sup>th</sup>.

Each presenter will be assigned one side of a 4 by 8 foot framed tack board oriented horizontally. Posters can be attached to the tackboard by pushpins, tacks, staples, Velcro, or tape. It is the responsibility of the presenter to provide materials for attaching illustrations to the tack board, a title sheet for the tack board, and any specimen labels needed. Please plan your presentation to fit within the described layout. Secured cabinets will be available, by prior arrangement, in the nearby mineral exhibit for displaying a limited number of special specimens. Additional equipment for the booth area such as 4 foot-long tables, chairs and electrical outlets may be requested by writing the Geological Society of Nevada, attention: Eric Struhsacker, P.O. Tables are limited in number by available floor space and are offered on a first-come, first-served basis. Requests should be received by April 1, 2010 and should include presenter's name and poster title.
