### Chuck Thorman - GSN Scholarship Fund General Guidelines

#### GENERAL ELIGIBILITY OF CANDIDATES

The **Chuck Thorman-GSN Scholarship Fund** shall be used to assist in the education of undergraduate or graduate students studying at an accredited university for a degree in the earth sciences and a research project with a major component of geologic mapping.

There are no requirements regarding age, sex, citizenship, race or religion.

The scholarship pool for 2024 is **\$4,000**. The amount to be awarded will be determined following the committee's evaluation of the applicant pool.

Any successful recipients will be assisted for a maximum period of two years.

All scholarship awards must meet the following criteria:

- All candidates must be full-time students studying at an accredited university for a
  degree in the earth sciences and have a research project with a major component of
  geologic mapping in Nevada or the Great Basin.
- The candidate must be a student member in good standing of GSN (<a href="www.gsnv.org">www.gsnv.org</a>). Student membership in the GSN is \$25 and provides access to the membership directory, digital newsletter and e-mail distribution of employment opportunities.
- The scholarship award money will be spent on field work related to the student's degree program and specifically to completing geologic mapping,

Candidates will submit an application that contains the following:

- Personal/contact Information on the attached pages
- Current grade transcript
- One-to two-page statement of career goals and experience
- Reference letters from one professor and one work supervisor
